

## Annette **GERANIUM PRATENSE**



Fabulous as a filler in a mixed perennial or shrub border, Geranium 'Annette' will delight for months on end with her mass of azure-blue flowers, which float like little blue butterflies over attractive, deeply dissected mid-green foliage. Bees flock to 'Annette' and she prefers plenty of sunshine to perform her best flowering and stay tidy. A spreading habit makes her a great weed suppressor and a trim in mid-summer will tidy any wayward growth and refresh her for the rest of the season. Plant in friable, free draining soil, in full sun. Cut back hard in winter, to encourage fresh new spring growth. Evergreen.
