Cha Cha (Dance Series)

CORDYLINE AUSTRALIS



Unusual and distinctive earthy colourings, of bright apricot and brown on new growth, provide a major talking point for this Cordyline from the superior Dancing Series, bred in New Zealand. Softly arching foliage then matures to yellow and green, producing a wonderful kaleidoscope of colour, perfect for imparting year-round interest in containers on the deck, patio or at an entranceway. Plant in free draining soil, in sun or semi-shade, in a sheltered position. Low maintenance plant. Evergreen.
