## Scarlet Storm

CHAENOMELES SPECIOSA



This spectacular flowering quince, Chaenomeles DOUBLE TAKE™ Scarlet Storm, not only looks like a perfect little rose at first glance, but, unlike most flowering quince, it is almost thornless! Masses of gorgeous, intense scarlet, flowers adorn the stems in early to late spring, providing a captivating garden display and stunning picking material for the vase. Cold, drought and heat tolerant once established, 'Scarlet Storm' forms a tidy mound making it a fantastic addition to a garden border or planted as a container specimen. Plant in part shade to full sun in well-drained, friable soil. Deciduous.
